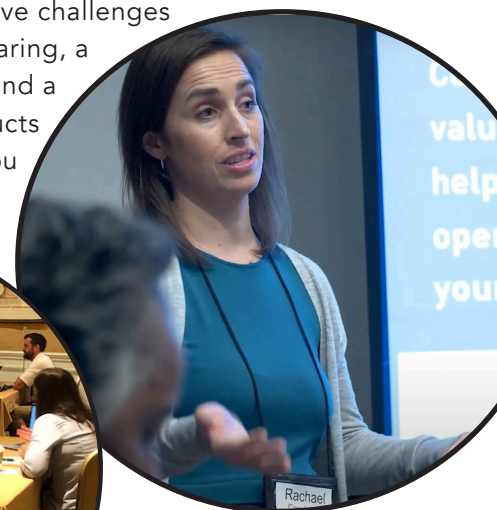

WHO'S ELIGIBLE TO HAVE ALL COSTS COVERED?

To be eligible, you must be responsible for a college or university recreation department with 2,000 undergrad students or higher. Your title should be Director, Manager, or Supervisor. Most important, you should have decision-making authority or specific input into the products and services your system purchases. You should also have challenges that you're interested in sharing, a willingness to help others and a desire to learn about products or services that can help you in the next 6 to 18 months.
